


#### How to interpret the figures in this presentation



- All figures presented relate to the 150+ NOCs completing the 2017 NOC Review, unless otherwise stated
- The figures show the situation as of 2017, unless otherwise stated
- Percentage averages have been calculated based on the average of the percentage of each NOC, not using aggregate absolute numbers. For example, a NOC with 10 staff members has been given the same weight as a NOC with 100 staff members when calculating the average share of NOC female staff members.









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### Olympic and non-Olympic sport federations make up 76% of the membership of the average NOC General Assembly (GA)









#### Olympic and non-Olympic sport federations make up 67% of the membership of the average NOC Executive Board (EB)









#### Overall, 54% of the secretaries general are elected by the GA






#### Overall, 48% of the secretaries general are volunteers





#### Overall, 74% of the secretaries general work full time









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

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


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
53% of the 154 NOCs own their headquarters or borrow it free of charge



Most NOCs who use their HQ free of charge receive this privilege from the government on their territory The "other" category is for example used when the legal status of the premises is not clearly defined




28% of the 154 NOCs own or operate sport facilities



Few NOCs actually own sport facilities: most of the NOCs who answered yes to this question help operating training facilities for their athletes.




78% of the 154 NOCs dispose of means of transport




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




96% of the 144 NOCs receive in-kind revenues






The single largest expense for NOCs is running costs and management followed by direct support to national federations (NFs)



The category "Other" contains i.e.: construction or repairs of venues or NOC HQ, investments, NOC commissions, Olympic education, ACP, marketing, and IOC / OS programmes

### 96% of the 142 NOCs use independent external auditors










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#### 76% of the 146 NOCs collaborate with a university






- The type of collaboration varies greatly between NOCs, i.e.
  - Olympic education events and conferences (most common)
  - Sports activities
  - o Olympic Day celebration
  - Dual career approach
  - o Research/Programme implementation
  - Hosting lectures for sports training courses
  - NOC donations to university library to buy books about Olympism
  - University Games cooperation
- 42% of the universities collaborating with NOCs offer special programmes for elite athletes




92.5% of the **NOCs promote Olympism** through programmes; **88% have** programmes targeting schools






70% of the NOCs have an institution promoting Olympism on their territory, the most common being a National **Olympic Academy** 




### 80% of the 146 NOCs provide athlete support programmes; 61% provide athlete education programmes






### Facebook has become the NOCs' most common public communications tool before twitter (not counting NOC websites)





# 40% of the 139 NOCs have measures in place aiming at integrating sustainability in their daily operations










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
# 43% of the 149 NOCs receive Games uniforms from a sponsor








Globally, 74% of the NOCs have their athletes covered by insurance(s) during the Games





Globally, 68% of the NOCs conducted antidoping tests prior to the Olympic Games








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






6.8% of the NOC presidents and 15.2% of the NOC Secretary Generals are women
